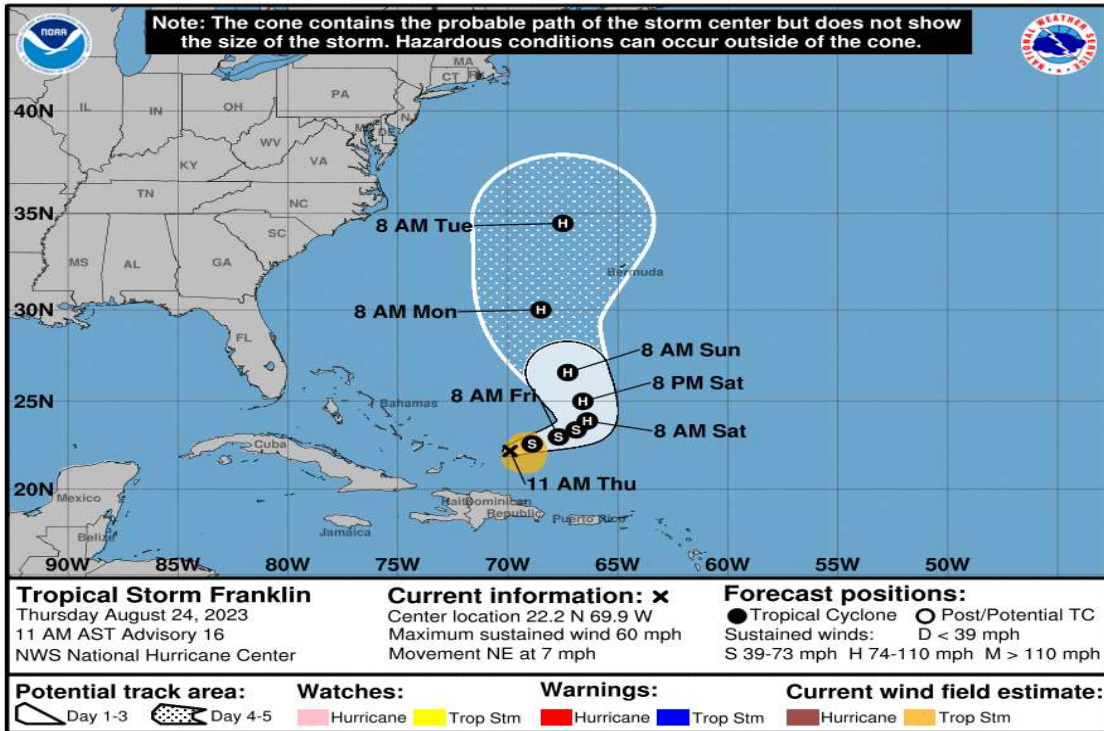




TROPICAL STORM FRANKLIN FINAL SITUATION REPORT

11:00 AM on August 24, 2023

All Clear Issued for Haiti and Turks and Caicos



HIGHLIGHTS:

According to the National Hurricane Centre in Miami, Florida, as of 11:00 AM (AST) on Thursday August 24, 2023, the center of Tropical Storm Franklin was located at 22.2 N 69.9 W with maximum sustained winds of 60 mph moving north-east at 7 mph. TS Franklin was located approximately 90 miles or 145 KM east north-east of Grand Turk Island. The Tropical Storm Warnings for Haiti and Turks and Caicos Islands have been discontinued and the All Clear has been issued. The impact to the states was minimal and no significant damage was reported. TS Franklin is forecast to produce 1 to 3 inches of rainfall across Hispaniola and the eastern Turks and Caicos Islands throughout Thursday, August 24, 2023.

Updates from Participating States Threatened/Impacted



HAITI

- The Tropical Storm Warning for Haiti has been discontinued and the All Clear has been issued.
- The Haitian Civil Protection Agency is awaiting official reports from the Northeastern and Southeastern Regions.
- No significant damage was reported, at the time of the report.



TURKS AND CAICOS

- The Tropical Storm Warning for Turks and Caicos has been discontinued and the ALL Clear has been issued.
- The EOCs in the eastern islands have been stood down.
- Emergency Shelters have been closed.
- The Department of Disaster Management and Emergencies (DDME) advised that the impact was minimal, and no damage reports were received.
